While we seldom forget to ready our homes for Christmas, we frequently do forget to ready ourselves. The primary theme of Christmas is that God's only-begotten took on human flesh in order to reveal God to us in a most perfect way so that we might truly know Him. Then, before His physical ascension to His Father's kingdom, Jesus left us His mystical Body and Blood to unite us to Him as one Body and, through Him, to one another. Therefore, during this Advent season, we should remember not only the gift-giving of St. Nicholas but also Him Who became one of us so that we might enter into His Father's kingdom ...
